



MHYF Collegiate Scholarship

2022 Guidelines

Miniature Hereford Youth Foundation Mission:

The Miniature Hereford Youth Foundation was established to promote youth involvement in the breeding, management, showing, and marketing of Miniature Hereford Cattle through developing leadership skills and educational programs, encouraging personal growth, as well as providing a pathway towards attaining grants and awarding scholarships.

The MHYF Collegiate Scholarship will be open to all MHBA youth members who are current College students. Award amount (\$) and number of scholarship recipients for a given year will be based on the number of qualified applicants and available funds. Preference may be given to applicants who have **not** previously received an MHYF Collegiate scholarship. Only 2022 application forms will be accepted; all others will be disqualified.

Application is due to the Director of Scholarships by December 17, 2021.

Applicant Qualifications

1. The student, the students' parents, Grandparents, or guardians must be current paid members of the MHBA in good standing (an MHBA Member in Good Standings has had 3 years of continuous paid membership without lapse) and remain a paid member of the MHBA either through a Junior or Family membership throughout the school year in which the Scholarship is awarded (i.e. academic year 2022-2023).
2. The applicant must be currently attending a two or four-year college, university, or vocational school in the academic year 2021-2022; or be a newly-applying non-traditional college student (i.e. you did not immediately begin collegiate education following high school graduation).
3. Minimum collegiate Grade Point Average (GPA) is a 2.75 (on a 4.0 scale) or equivalent for currently enrolled students. High school GPA may be considered for newly-applying non-traditional collegiate students.
4. The applicant must plan to be continually enrolled as a part-time or full-time student at the school of their choice.

Application Deadline and Selection Process

1. The completed 2022 MHYF Collegiate Scholarship application must be **received** by the Director of Scholarships by **December 17, 2021**. The **completed application** must be sent either via email **OR** general delivery to the address provided on the requirements page of the scholarship application. Postmarks on 12-17-2021 will be accepted as meeting the deadline. **No late applications will be accepted.**
2. The MHYF Scholarship Committee will meet and conduct interviews for qualified applicants attending the 2022 World Miniature Hereford Show in Denver, CO. Those qualified applicants unable to attend the World Show will be contacted for telephone or Zoom interviews. The interview process will be completed prior to announcing the scholarship recipients at the Annual Banquet of the MHBA. You do not need to be present to receive an award.

Payment of Scholarships

Scholarship awards will be mailed directly to the students' college of choice for application to student tuition and fees in the school year 2022-2023. Scholarship awards will never be mailed directly to the student.

Required Information

The applicant must submit a properly completed official MHYF scholarship application packet with the following required components. Neatness in preparation of the application shall be considered. Any incomplete or missing information will result in **disqualification** for the scholarship and the said application will thereby *not* be accepted.

1. Completed MHYF Collegiate scholarship application.
2. Statement of Applicant and Parent/Guardian signature form.
3. Statement of Applicants' College Department Head and/or Academic Advisor.
4. Media release form.
5. Attachment #1: Unofficial Collegiate transcript (current to the time of application) – must list each course taken, grades received, grade points, and credit hours.
6. Completed and attached MHYF Collegiate Scholarship Application Checklist.
7. In addition to the above requirements to be sent to the Director of Scholarships, please also email one recent head and shoulder photo (jpeg) of the applicant to duval.alyssa3@gmail.com with applicant name in the subject line. Polaroid, other instant prints, or photos printed on paper are not acceptable. Photo may be color or black and white. Photo must be high quality.

Additional Recommended Information

While not officially required as part of the Collegiate scholarship application, the following supporting documents are highly recommended for the applicant to include within the submitted application. These documents may be used by the MHYF Scholarship Committee as tie-breakers in consideration of scholarship award quantity and award amount.

1. Submit at least one Letter of Recommendation from a source (employer, school teacher, etc.) other than a relative.
2. Submit at least one Letter of Recommendation from a Miniature Hereford breeder (MHBA and MHYF Board members as well as applicant relatives are excluded).
